COMMERCIAL: DEPOSIT TRANSFER TOOL



User Guide

When you receive incoming funds for multiple, project related orders, use the **Deposit Transfer Tool** to transfer the funds from a source order (order receiving lump sum incoming funds) to the corresponding destination order(s) (orders receiving internal fund transfer). The **Deposit Transfer Tool (DTT)** allows you to create and post Ledger Transfers to one or multiple orders.

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Key Items to Remember

The **Deposit Transfer Tool** does **not** save your data and there is no refresh button. All information selected/entered is cleared if the **Deposit Transfer Tool** window is closed prior to posting deposits.

IMPORTANT: Key items to verify **prior** to using the **Deposit Transfer Tool**,

- > Project name
 - » source order and destination order(s) have the same project name entered in the **Project name** field; limited to 100 characters



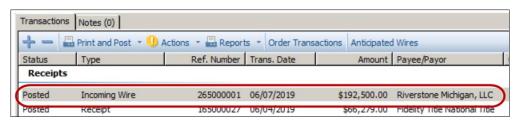
> Trust Account

» destination order(s) must have the same Trust Account as the source order; if not, the (destination) order is disabled in the Deposit Transfer Tool



> Pending Disbursement

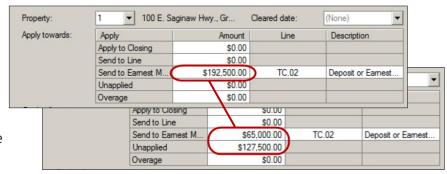
- » verify the source order has a **Pending Disbursement** to the party to be identified as **Payee (Master)**;
- if the source order does not have a Pending Disbursement,
 - i. Double-clickthe **PostedReceipt**







- ii. In the **Unapplied** field, enter the total amount to be transferred
- iii. Overwrite the original amount with the adjusted amount (receipted amount less the transfer)



- iv. Click the **OK** button
- v. When prompted, enter a reason for the modification
- vi. Click the **OK** button

Overview

Access the **Deposit Transfer Tool** via the **Commercial** tab > **Deposit Transfer Tool** button when in your source order.



When opened, the **Deposit Transfer Tool** window shows the,

Source Order Information

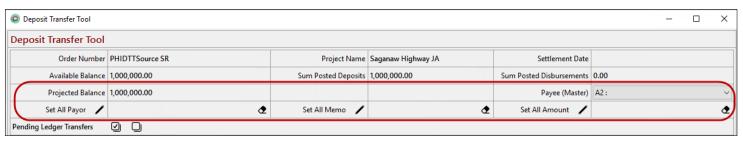


- » Order Number
- » Project Name
- » Settlement Date
- » Available Balance (Ledger balance)
- » Sum Posted Deposits
- » Sum Posted Disbursements



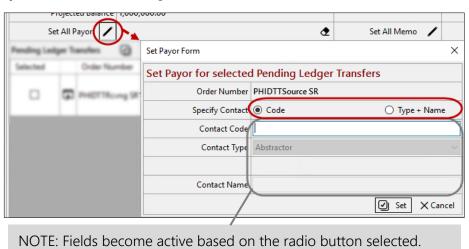


> Information for deposit transfers,

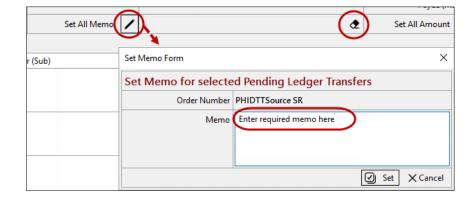


- » Projected Balance; this is a running Ledger Balance and changes as transfers are entered
- » Payee (Master); this is the payee of the disbursement in the source order and shows as the payee of the Ledger Transfer when funds are posted in the destination order(s)
- » Set All Payor; to set the same Payor for all transfers using the,
 - Contact Code; key in the code you wish to use
 - ► Type + Name; select the Contact type and key in the name

IMPORTANT: Revenue Contacts (i.e., **A**, **T**, **U**) are **never** to be entered as the **Payor**.



Set All Memo; click the icon to enter the same notation for all transfers; click the Clear Set All Memo icon to clear



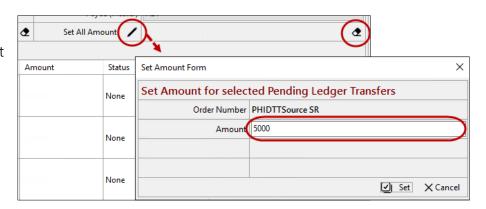
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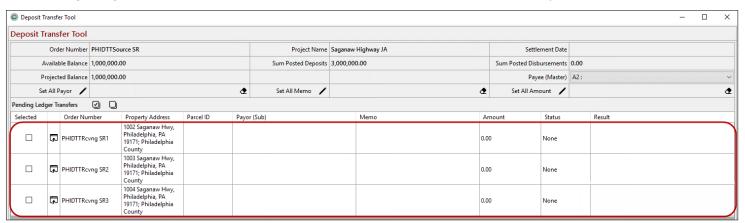


Set All Amount; click the icon to enter the amount when transferring the same amount to multiple destination orders; click the

Clear Set All Amount icon to clear



Pending Ledger Transfers grid populates with the orders containing the same Project name

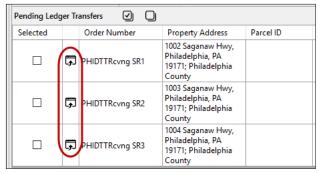


» Selected check box; used to select individual destination orders



» Open Order icon; click the icon to open the corresponding destination order

NOTE: Clicking the **Open Order** icon minimizes the **Deposit Transfer Tool** window; it is still open and active behind the SoftPro Select window.

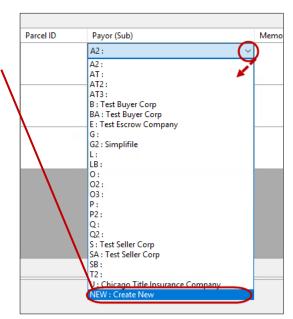

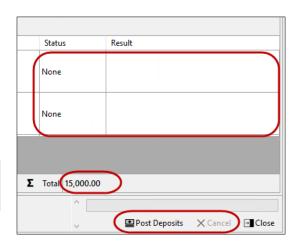
- » Order Number; destination order number
- » Property Address (only displays the first property entered in the destination order
- » Parcel ID (only displays the first property entered in the destination order)
- » Payor (Sub)
 - ▶ shows all **Contacts** entered in the destination order
 - includes a Create New entry allowing you to add a Contact
 - ▶ is the Payor on the posted receipt in the destination order

REMEMBER: Revenue Contacts (i.e., **A**, **T**, **U**) are **never** to be entered as the **Payor** (**Sub**).



- » Memo; (required) enter a brief memo for the applicable order
- » Amount; enter the funds to be transferred to the individual destination order
- » Status; auto-populate as the transfer is processed
- » Total; shows the calculated total of the transfers entered
- » Post Deposits; use to post and transfer funds when all information is entered
- » Cancel; use to cancel any entered transfers prior to their being posted

NOTE: When cancelling you must click the **Cancel** button then the **Close** button to continue.

Entering Deposit Transfers

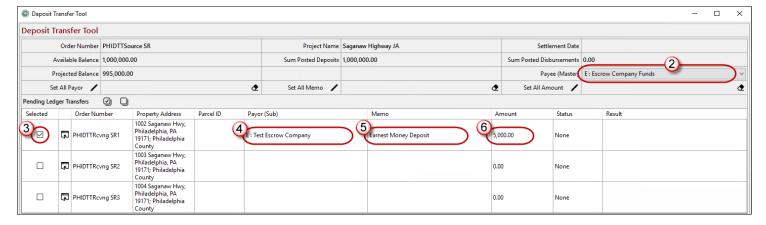
There are several options when entering deposit transfers,

- > Individual deposit transfers allows you to select a payor and deposit amount for each destination order
- > Multiple deposit transfers allows you to enter the,
 - » same (or different) payor and different amounts to each destination order
 - -Or-
 - » same payor and same amount to each destination order

Individual Deposit Transfers

Once incoming funds are posted to your source order and you are ready to transfer funds,

- 1. Click the **Commercial** tab > **Deposit Transfer Tool** button
- 2. From the Payee (Master) drop-down, select the Contact for the disbursement in the source order
- 3. Check the Selected check box for the corresponding destination order
- 4. From the Payor (Sub) drop-down, select an applicable Contact
- 5. **Memo**; (required) enter a brief memo
- 6. In the **Amount** field, enter the amount to be deposited to the selected destination order



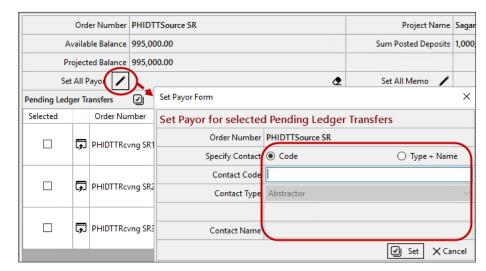
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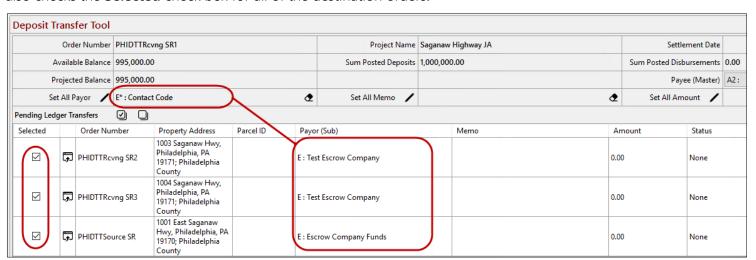


Multiple Deposit Transfers - Same Payor, Different Amounts

- 1. Click the **Set All Payor** icon (above the grid)
- Check the Code applicable radio button (Code or Type+Name)
- Enter/select the corresponding Contact information; click the Set button

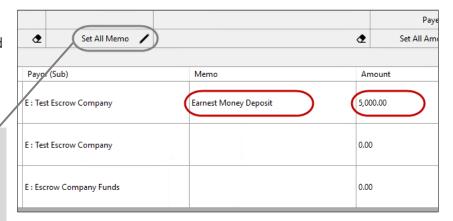


The selection populates the **Set All Payor** field and the **Payor (Sub)** field in the grid with the Contact selected. This also checks the **Selected** check box for all of the destination orders.



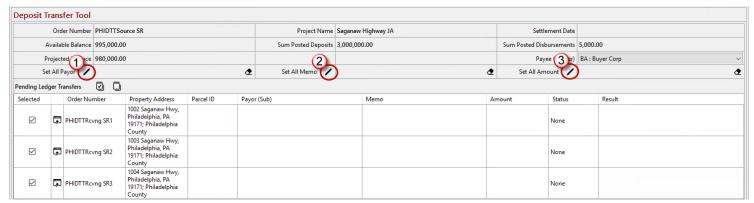
- 4. **Memo,** (required) enter a brief memo
- 5. **Amount,** enter the amount for the selected destination order
- 6. Repeat **Steps 4-5** for each remaining destination order

REMEMBER: You can use the **Set All Memo** option if entering the same
memo for all of the deposit transfers. If
this is used, you need only enter the **Amount** for your remaining transfers.

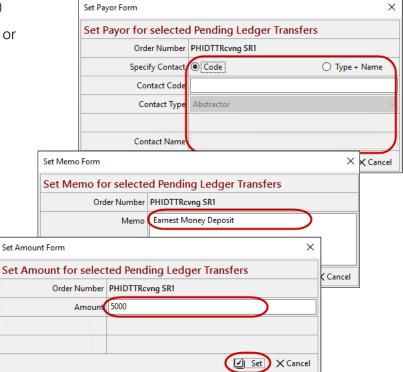




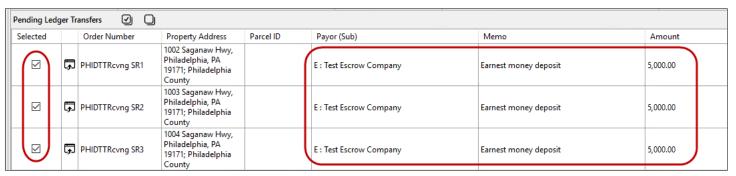
Multiple Deposit Transfers - Same Payor, Memo and Amounts



- 1. Click the **Set All Payor** icon (above the grid)
 - a. Check the applicable radio button (Code or Type+Name)
 - b. Enter/select the corresponding **Contact** information
 - c. Click the **Set** button
- 2. Click the **Set All Memo** icon
 - a. Enter the corresponding memo
 - b. Click the **Set** button
- 3. Click the **Set All Amount** icon
 - a. Enter the amount to be transferred to all destination orders
 - b. Click the **Set** button



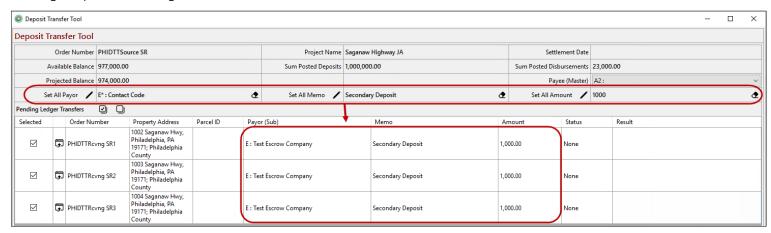
All destination orders are selected and have the same Payor (Sub), Memo and Amount to be transferred.





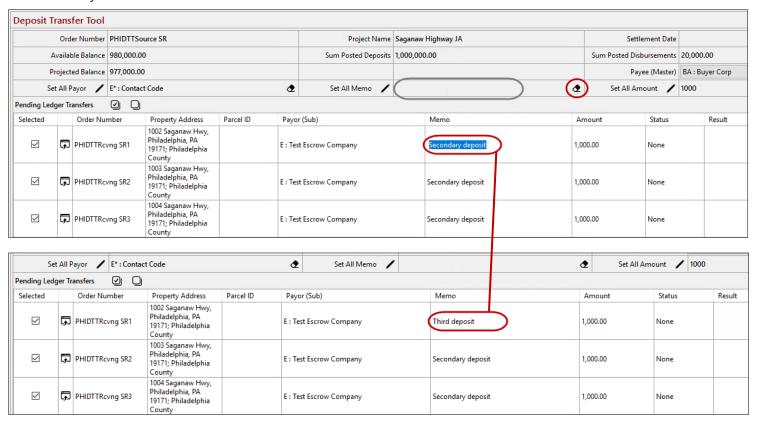
Editing an Entry

If using the **Set All** option to enter the **Payor**, **Memo** or **Amount**, the fields in the **Pending Ledger Transfer** grid are no longer open for editing.



If you need to edit an individual entry when using the Set All options,

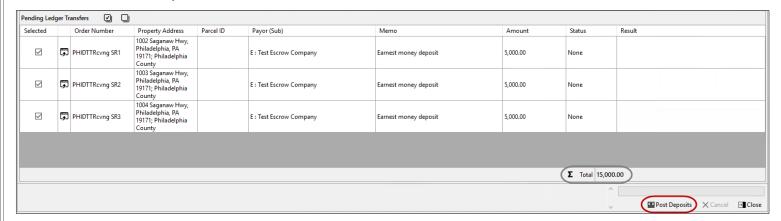
- 1. Click the Clear All icon of the entry you need to edit; this removes the Set All entry in the settings but does not remove it from the Pending Ledger Transfers grid
- 2. Highlight the entry you wish to edit in the Pending Ledger Transfers grid
- 3. Enter your new information





Posting the Transfer(s)

1. Click the **Post Deposits** button

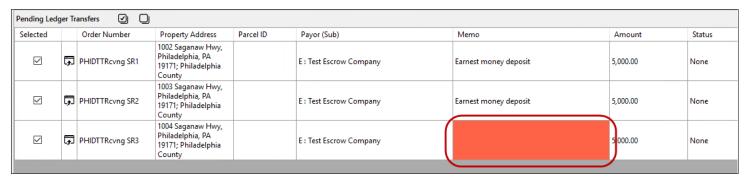


The **Deposit Transfer Tool** window displays a running total of all **Pending Ledger Transfers** entered.

Missing Information

If required information is missing, the **Deposit Transfer Tool** window,

highlights the field missing the required information (i.e., Payor (Sub), Memo or Amount fields)



You cannot proceed with any transfers until the required information is entered/selected.

- 1. Enter/select the missing information and press
- 2. Press the Post Deposits button

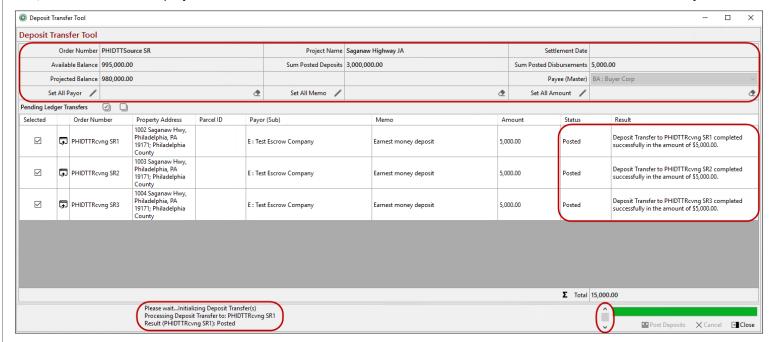
The program begins to process the transfers and the status is displayed at the bottom of the screen.





Once posting is complete,

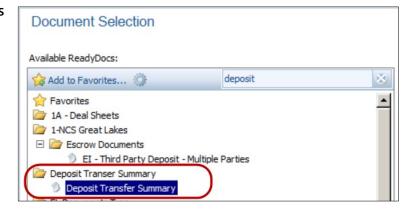
- Fields are locked on the Deposit Transfer Tool window
- The **Status** and **Result** fields identify the transfers were processed/completed
- Status is also displayed at the bottom of the screen; use the scroll bar to see the final status (last entry)



> The **Register > Notes** screen identifies deposit(s) was posted from the order identifying the date, time and reference number of the posted ledger transfer. If a transfer is unsuccessful, the amount shows as zero.



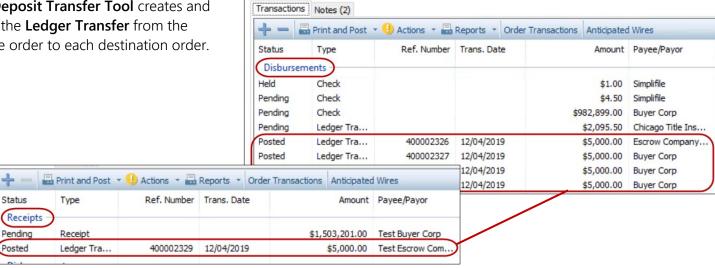
Users can generate a report from the **Documents Deposit Transfer Summary** showing all successful/unsuccessful transfers for the source order







The **Deposit Transfer Tool** creates and posts the **Ledger Transfer** from the source order to each destination order.



The **Ledger Transfer(-)** in the source and destination orders show,

- From receipt number = DTT indicating it is a Deposit Transfer Tool entry
- **Memo** = the memo entered on the **Deposit Transfer Tool** window
- Extended Memo is autopopulated with "This ledger transfer was created and posted by [user name] using the Deposit Transfer Tool"
- Payee = Contact selected on the **Deposit Transfer Tool > Payee** (Master)
- Payor = Contact selected on the Deposit Transfer Tool > Payor (Sub)
- Amount; funds are posted to the Apply towards > Apply to **Closing** field
