




Follow these steps to move a single or multiple Exceptions, Requirements, or Subordinate Matters while in SoftPro Select.

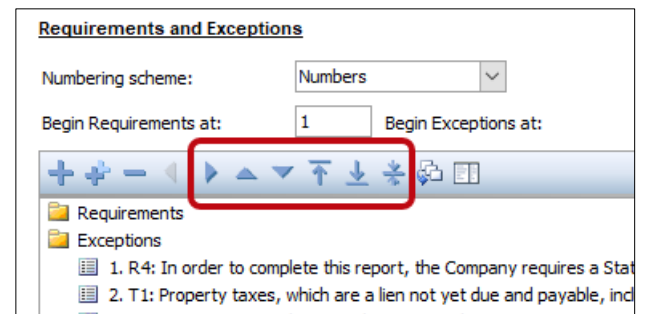
The ability to move single or multiple phrases has been added for the following screens:

- › **Commitment – Schedules B1, B2** (Requirements and Exceptions)
- › **Policy – Schedules B1, B2** (Exceptions and Subordinate Matters)
- › **Endorsements** (Requirements, Exceptions and Subordinate Matters)
- › **Escrow Instructions**
- › **Deed** (Restrictions/Easements/Exceptions)

Three new icons have been added to the grid toolbar and the existing **Up/Down** icons have been updated to accommodate the moving multiple entries.



The newly added options (with updated/new icons) are:

- › **Move Up/Down**  – move one level up/down
- › **Move to Top/Bottom**  – move to the top/bottom
- › **Group Together**  – group multiple selections together (after the first phrase)
- › **Drag and Drop** – drag and drop a single or multiple selections after a current phrase

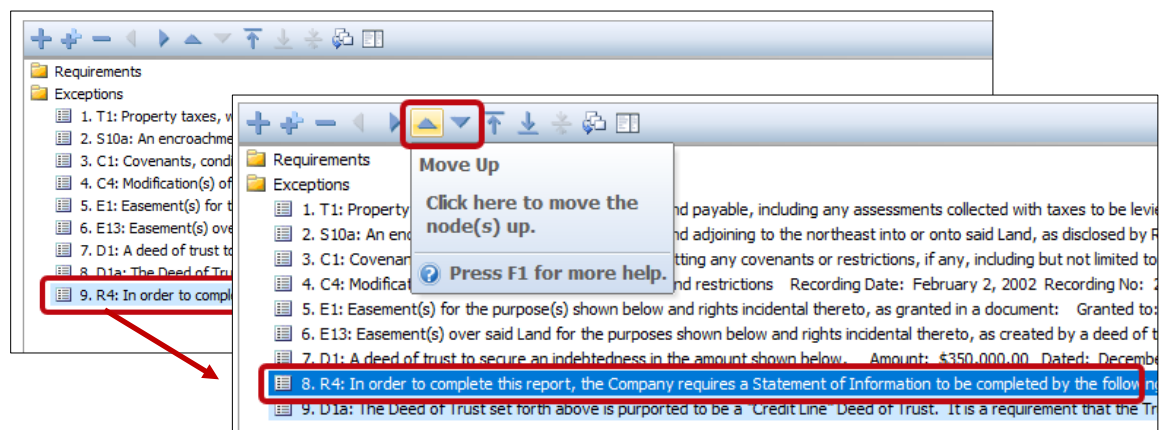


Moving Phrases One Level

The current functionality of moving a single phrase up/down one level at a time still exists but now you can move multiple phrases (in succession) up/down one level at a time.

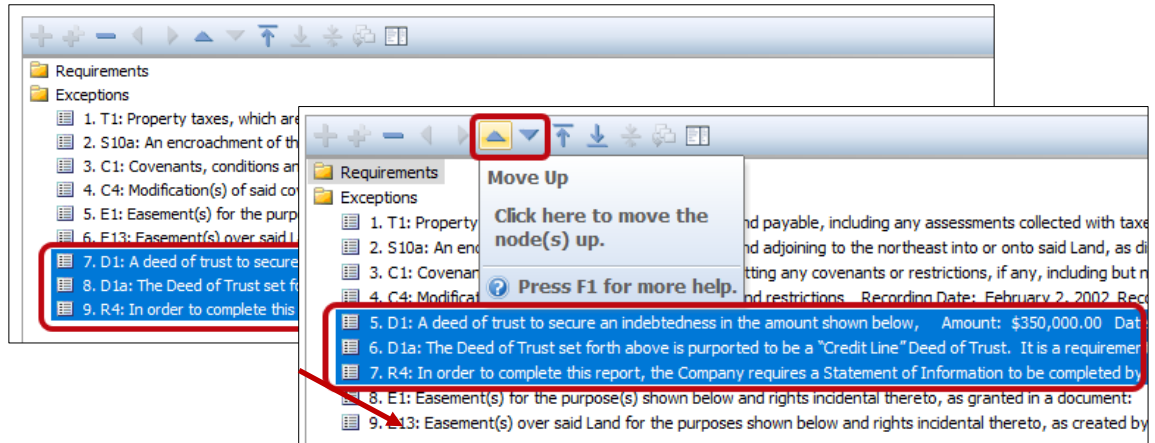
1. Select a single phrase or multiple phrases grouped together
2. Click the **Move Up**  or **Move Down**  icon to move the phrase(s) up/down one level at a time

Exception **R4** moved from #9 to #8.



NOTE: When moving multiple selected phrases, the selections must all be at the same level.



Exceptions **D1**, **D1a**, and **R4** moved from #7, 8, and 9 to #5, 6, and 7.



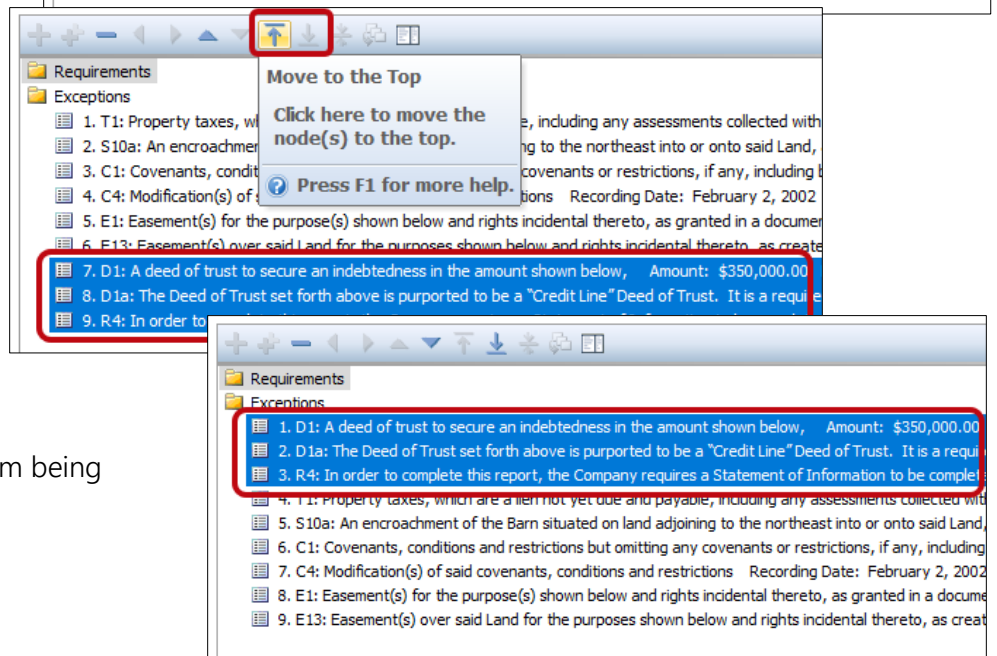
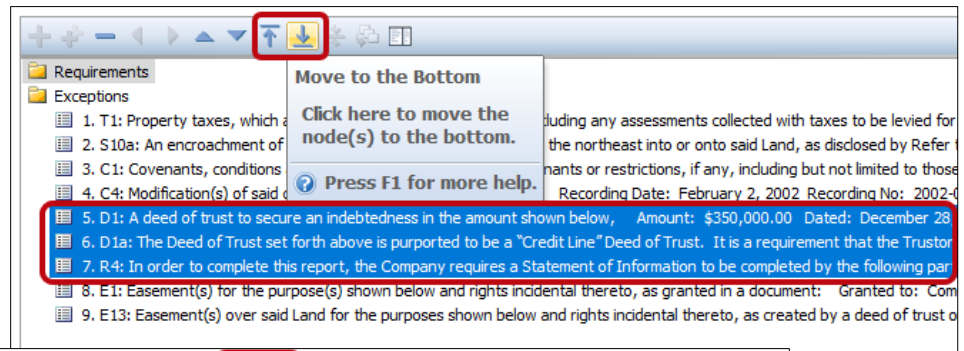
Moving Phrases to the First/Last Position

1. Select a phrase or multiple phrases grouped together (if multiple hold the **SHIFT** key once the first phrase is selected to select the next phrase)

NOTE: When moving multiple phrases, the selections must all be at the same level.


2. Click the **Move to the Top**  or **Move to the Bottom**  icon

Exceptions **D1**, **D1a**, and **R4** moved from being #5, 6, and 7 to #7, 8, and 9.



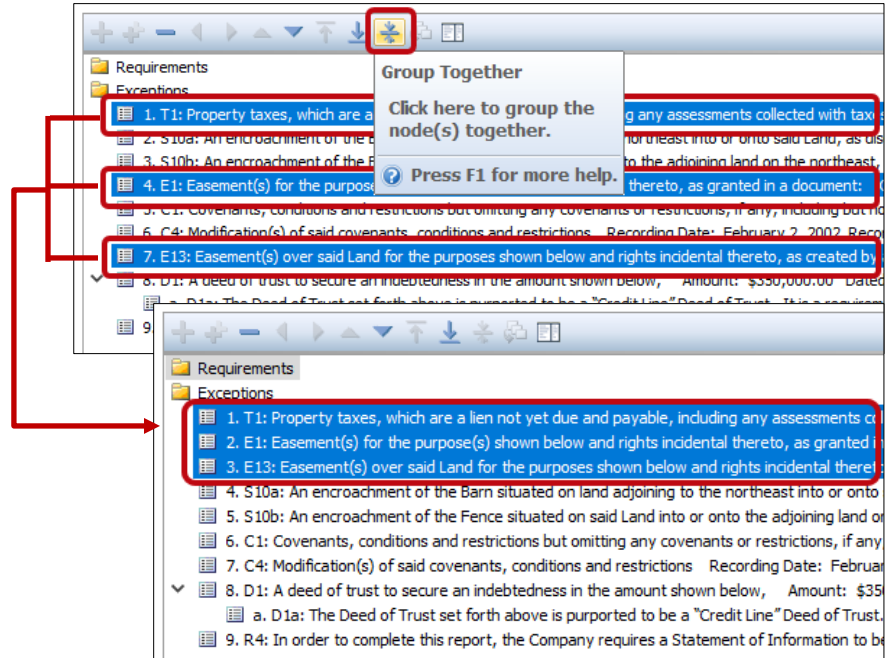
Exceptions **D1**, **D1a**, and **R4** moved from being #7, 8, and 9 to #1, 2, and 3.

Grouping Multiple Phrases Together

1. Click on the first phrase
2. Holding the **CTRL** key click each additional phrase you wish to group together
3. Click the **Group Together**  icon

Exceptions **T1**, **E1** and **E13** moved from being #1, 4 and 6 to #1, 2, and 3.

When grouping phrases, they move to the position of the first selection.



Other toolbar functions can be used to move the grouped phrases up/down one level or to the top/bottom position.

Drag and Drop Phrases

1. Select a single phrase or multiple phrases (multiple phrases must be grouped together)
2. Holding the **SHIFT** key drag and drop the selections on the phrase you wish them to appear after
