


## **Entering and Splitting POC Charges on the HUD-1**

Follow these steps to enter POC and Partial POC items so they appear correctly on the GFE Comparison, (HUD-1 Page 3).

#### **Entering a Full POC**

- Navigate to the Loan Charges (800) screen
- 2. Enter the full amount of the charge in the **Borrower** column on the appropriate line
- Expand the Payor more/less bar for the line you are working on in the grid
- 4. Check the **POC** check box



This moves the charge out of the Borrower column and displays as P.O.C.\$450.00(B)\* in the Re field.



### **Entering a Partial POC**

 In the Loan Charges (800) screen, enter the full amount of the charge in the Borrower column on the appropriate line






## **Entering and Splitting POC Charges on the HUD-1**

- 2. Expand the Payors more/less bar for the line you are working on in the grid
- 3. In the Amount field, overwrite the entry with the amount paid outside of closing; press the Enter key

This creates a second entry for the balance of the charge.


4. Check the **POC** check box next to the amount paid outside of closing



The POC item displays as **P.O.C.\$35.00(B)\*** in the **Re** field and the balance to be paid at closing remains in the **Borrower** column.



The POC items properly display on the GFE Comparison (HUD-1, Page 3):







# **Entering and Splitting POC Charges on the HUD-1**

NOTE: POC item(s) are not properly displayed on the **GFE Comparison (HUD-1, Page 3)** if manually entered in the **Re** field.

Red text indicates manually entered POC information in the Re, Borrower and HUD-1 To Name fields.



These entries appear incorrectly on the GFE Comparison, (HUD-1, Page 3).
