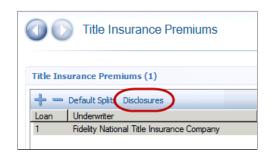


An enhancement has been made with the v4.1 upgrade, affecting how Title Insurance Premiums are shown in SoftPro Select. The SI Net Owner Premium and the Full Loan Premium amounts continue to be displayed on the CD line (in compliance with CFPB Regulations), however, on Simultaneous Issue policies, if the check box for **Show full premium on CDF/HUD-1** is checked, the **Final** Loan /Owner's Premiums are then shown in the,

- Line detail Payors/Payees grids
- Register (Ledger Transfer)
- Revenue Reports (i.e., Single Ledger Balance and Disbursement Summary)

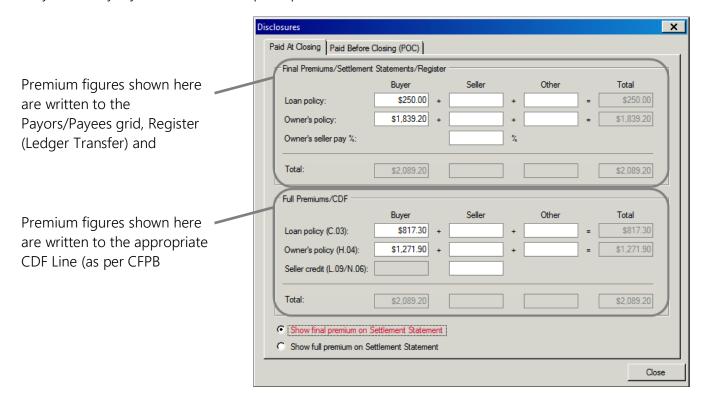
In addition to how the premiums are displayed, a **Disclosures** button has been added to the **Title Insurance Premiums** screen.

NOTE: The Keyboard Shortcut, **Ctrl + Alt +D**, also opens the **Disclosures** window from anywhere in Select.



#### Use of the **Disclosures** window,

- allows for a quick view of how the charges appear on the CDF Line
- provides the ability to edit premiums without having to navigate to the CDF page
- is only necessary if your transaction requires premium edits

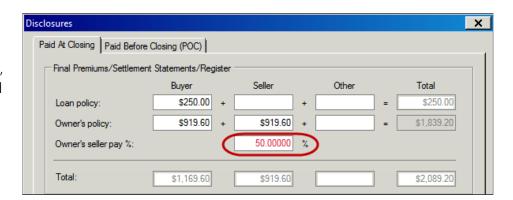




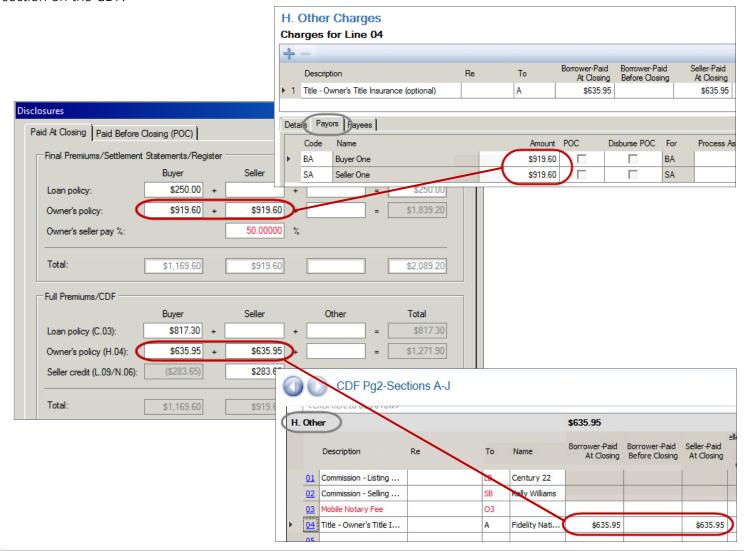
When changes to the premium(s) are necessary, follow the steps in the appropriate section below.

#### Seller-Pay Percentage Change

- Press Ctrl + Alt +D to open the Disclosures window
- 2. In the **Owner's Seller pay%** field, enter the percentage to be paid
- 3. Click the Close button



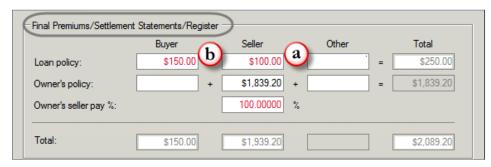
The premium figures automatically update according to the percentage entered and written to the corresponding section on the CDF.





#### Seller Paying a Portion of the Loan Premium

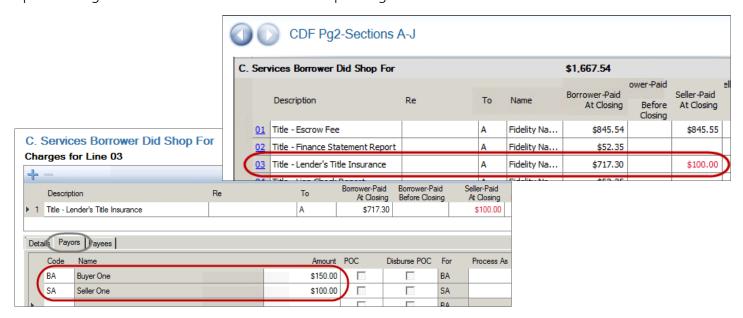
- 1. Press Ctrl + Alt +D to open the Disclosures window
- 2. In the Final Premiums/Settlement Statement/Register section,
  - a) In the Loan policy > Seller field, enter the amount to be paid
  - b) In the Loan policy > Buyer field, overwrite with the balance due



- 3. In the Full Premiums/CDF section,
  - a) In the Loan policy >
     Seller field, enter the
     amount to be paid (this
     is the same amount
     entered in Step 2a)
- 4. Click the **Close** button



The premium figures entered are written to the corresponding section on the CDF.



REMEMBER: Information entered on the **Title Insurance premiums** screen flows to the **Disclosure** window which flows to the **CDF Pg2** (or **Pg3**, as appropriate).



#### Lender-Paid Premium

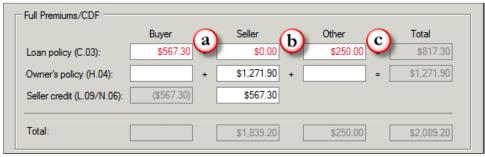
- 1. Press Ctrl + Alt +D to open the Disclosures window
- 2. In the Final Premiums/Settlement Statement/Register section,
  - a) In the Loan policy >
     Other field, enter the amount to be paid by the Lender
  - b) In the **Loan policy > Buyer** field, overwrite with *O (zero)*



- 3. In the Full Premiums/CDF section,
  - a) In the Loan policy > Buyer field, overwrite the amount reduced by the Lender-paid amount (in our

example the Lender is paying \$250, so we entered \$567.50 (817.50 – 250)

b) In the Loan policy > Seller field, overwrite with *O (zero)* 

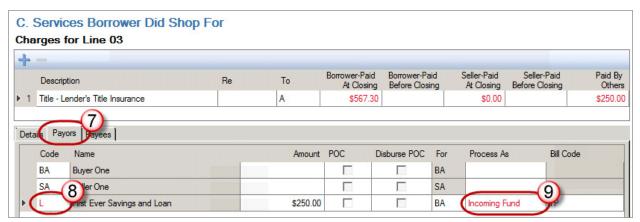


- c) In the Loan policy >
   Other field, enter the amount to be paid by the Lender (this is the same amount entered in Step 2a)
- 4. Click the **Close** button
- 5. Navigate to the CDF Pg2-Sections A-J screen
- 6. Click the Line number link for Title Lender's Title Insurance





- 7. Click the Payors tab
- 8. From the **Code** drop-down, select the **L**-Contact
- 9. From the Process As drop-down, select Incoming Fund



- 10. Click the Close button
- 11. Print/Publish CDF/Statement as normal
