


Adding a 500 Event to an Existing Order

Once the Prelim/Commitment has been reviewed for payoffs, judgments, tax liens, etc., and the file is cleared to close, add a 500 Event to notify the Lender. Follow these steps to add the 500 Event.

- 1. Open the order you wish to add the 500 Event to; make sure all other orders are closed
- 2. If you are not already logged into **360**, log in
- 3. From the **360** ribbon, click the **Queue** button (or if logged in, click the **Queue** tab at the bottom of the screen)



4. From the Views drop-down, select Active Orders to ensure you are working in the order you intend to add the event


5. Highlight the **Product** entry to which you are adding the event; this event is only available for 3 -**Commitment Prelim Report**

NOTE: If you don't have the **Product** column displayed,


- > From the Queue toolbar, click the **Columns** icon




